

BUSINESS AND NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

Public Use of School Fields and Playgrounds

School fields and playgrounds shall be open for public use when school is not in session, subject to the following prohibitions, except when it is determined by the school principal that damage to school property or other illegal activity by users requires closing the fields and playgrounds to public use.

No field or playground shall be used for activities potentially dangerous to users such as golfing, skateboarding, or operation of gasoline-powered model airplanes, motorcycles, and go-carts.

Fields and playgrounds shall be posted with signs prohibiting activities unlawful under California codes or under Board of Education policy.

School grounds shall be posted as follows:
