**High School Summer School
General Information 2017**

ELIGIBILITY and SITES

High School summer school is open to any Long Beach Unified School District student who need to make up credit(s) required for graduation, fulfill A-G college entrance requirements or take a math preparation course. Post eighth graders through post-twelfth graders should see their counselors regarding eligibility for specific core academic or district-funded courses. Summer school enrollment is limited to those who attend a Long Beach Unified School District high school. A minimum of 85% attendance is required for credit. Students will not receive a passing grade if they are absent more than 10 hours (4 days) from a full session course. All students must be enrolled for class credit.

Cabrillo, Jordan, Lakewood, Millikan, Poly and Wilson High Schools will be open to students from post-eighth to post-twelfth grades. Current high school students should attend summer school at the site where they attend the regular school year. Students from Beach, CAMS, McBride Reid, Renaissance and Sato should attend their neighborhood high school.

HEALTH REQUIREMENT: The “No Shot-No School” policy is in effect during the summer session.

DRESS CODE REQUIREMENT: The LBUSD dress code is enforced during summer school.

Uniforms are required at Millikan and Wilson High Schools.

FREE OR REDUCED LUNCHES: Lunches will be available to qualified students.

HOW TO ENROLL

- 1.) Complete the online application at www.lbschools.net/summer between April 10th and May 14th
You will need the following items:
 - Student ID
 - Student Email Address and Parent Email Address
- 2.) Students will receive an email, within 24-48 hours after completing the registration form, providing for next steps for class registration.
- 3.) If a student registers for Summer School during Spring Break (April 14th -21st), they will receive their email during the week of April 24th. The office will be closed for Spring Break, therefore no Summer School emails will be sent out until the following week. If you do not receive an email one week after you register, then please send an email to SummerLBUSD@lbschools.net to inform us of the problem.
