**High School Summer School  
General Information 2019**

**ELIGIBILITY and SITES**

High School summer school is open to any Long Beach Unified School District student who need to make up credit(s) required for graduation, fulfill A-G college entrance requirements or take a math preparation course. Post eighth graders through post-twelfth graders should see their counselors regarding eligibility for specific core academic or district-funded courses. **Summer school enrollment is limited to those who attend a Long Beach Unified School District high school.** A minimum of 85% attendance is required for credit. Students will not receive a passing grade if they are absent more than 10 hours (4 days) from a full session course. All students must be enrolled for class credit.

Cabrillo, Jordan, Lakewood, Millikan, Poly and Wilson High Schools will be open to students from post-eighth to post-twelfth grades. Current high school students should attend summer school at the site where they attend the regular school year. Students from Beach, Browning CAMS, McBride Reid, Renaissance and Sato should attend their neighborhood high school if the courses that they need are offered at that site. If the courses needed are not offered at their neighborhood school, then they can attend any school that offers the courses that are needed.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENT:** The “No Shot-No School” policy is in effect during the summer session.

**DRESS CODE REQUIREMENT:** The LBUSD dress code is enforced during summer school.

**Uniforms are required at Millikan and Wilson High Schools.**

**FREE OR REDUCED LUNCHESES:** Lunches will be available to qualified students.

**HOW TO ENROLL**

- 1.) Complete the online application at [www.lbschools.net/summer](http://www.lbschools.net/summer) between April 15<sup>th</sup> and May 3<sup>rd</sup>  
You will need the following items:
  - Student ID
  - Student Email Address and Parent Email Address
- 2.) Students will receive an on-screen notification, with a date/time stamp, indicating that they have been registered for Summer School.
- 3.) Students who would like to discuss the courses that they will take during the summer should meet with their Counselor by May. Otherwise, your Counselor will select the courses that you need to meet graduation or “a-g” requirements. A student or parent can view the courses requests, once the Counselor enters them, in StudentVue or ParentVue.
- 4.) **The deadline to submit the online summer school application is May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 5pm.**
