Thursday, November 15	9:30, 10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>Turkeys in the Wild</b>	K-4	Presents wild turkeys in nature throughout the year. Gives information about the turkey's habits and appearance. Suggests Thanksgiving art ideas. <b>20 minutes</b>

Friday, November 30	10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>Food For Fun, (2<sup>nd</sup> ed.)</b>	K-3	Shows the human need for balanced meals, cleanliness, and good manners. Uses a zoo full of animals to help teach two children health lessons.  <b>11 minutes</b>
