Teacher discretion: Contains sensitive material. <b>23 minutes</b>

Thursday, October 4	9:30, 10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>Beginning Responsibility: Learning To Be a Good Sport (2nd ed.)</b>	K-3	Illustrates good sportsmanship by depicting play situations at home and at school. <b>11 minutes</b>
Friday, October 5	10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>Study Skills: Take That Test</b>	4-8	Uses humor to help students develop good study habits; learn to follow and understand directions; intelligently answer multiple choice, true-false, and essay questions; plan one's time in relationship to the test; and appropriately respond if stumped. <b>18 minutes</b>
Tuesday, October 9	9:00, 9:30, 10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30, 1:00, 2:00	<b>Library World</b>	7-8	Shows students how much a library has to offer them. Explains the Dewey Decimal System, Reader's Guide, and other reference tools. <b>16 minutes</b>
Thursday, October 11	9:30, 10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>Going To School Is Your Job</b>	K-3	Encourages children to work together, follow basic rules of safety, and assume responsibility. Compares the child's role as student to that of parents, school faculty and community helpers. Presents basic rules about promptness to school, safety, care of personal belongings, cleanliness, and personal responsibility. <b>16 minutes</b>
Friday, October 12	10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>First Tuesday (Voter Registration)</b>	12	Presents a newscast set in the future which documents a protest movement to bring back elections. Produced by the San Diego County Registrar of Voters. <b>23 minutes</b>

Thursday, October 18	9:30, 10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>If Books Could Talk</b>	1-3	Illustrates seven important ways to take proper care of books.  <b>10 minutes</b>
Friday, October 19	10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>Operation School Bus Safety: Be Cool, Follow the Rules</b> (required viewing)	K-2	Helps teach children the rules of school bus safety. Demonstrates safe conduct on and around the school bus, and includes instruction on emergency evacuation.  <b>16 minutes</b>
Wednesday, October 24	8:00, 10:15, 11:30, 1:00, 2:00	<b>Halloween</b>	K-4	Teaches the folklore and origins behind the holiday's symbols, traditions and costumes.  <b>25 minutes</b>
Wednesday, October 25	8:00, 10:15, 11:30, 1:00, 2:00	<b>Taking Care of Your School Building</b>	K-3	Shows how students unthinkingly damage floors, walls, furniture, etc. Stresses the importance of developing a sense of pride to help alleviate the problem.  <b>15 minutes</b>
Friday, October 26	10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30	<b>McGruff on the Law: Bicycles and Pedestrians</b>	2-5	Explains why bicycle and pedestrian laws protect bicyclists and other people. Illustrates safety points children should always remember.  <b>18 minutes</b>
Tuesday, October 30	9:00, 9:30, 10:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30, 1:00, 2:00	<b>Molly's Pilgrim</b>	2-8	Tells the story of Molly, a Russian Jewish girl who has come to America with her family to escape persecution and enjoy religious freedom. Shows that there are many kinds of pilgrims.  <b>24 minutes</b>
