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SCHOOL DISTRICT SEEKING NEW PERSONNEL COMMISSIONER

The Long Beach Unified School District (LBUSD) is seeking applications for appointment to the Personnel Commission.

The Personnel Commission is the public body responsible for the administration of a “merit system” for the selection, retention and promotion of classified (i.e., non-teaching) employees in a public school system. By law, it is composed of three members appointed for three-year terms with the term of one member expiring each year.

The appointment will be to fill the vacancy of a Personnel Commissioner, which includes the remaining term. Personnel Commission appointments are selected and renewed for three-year terms beginning December 1st. The next three-year term of this position is December 1, 2018 to November 30, 2021.

In order to qualify, an applicant must be:

- ❖ A registered voter and a resident within the Long Beach Unified School District boundaries
- ❖ A known adherent of the Merit System (or civil-service system) and support the concept of employment, continuance in employment, in-service promotional opportunities and other related matters on the basis of merit and fitness

Additionally, an applicant cannot be a member of the LBUSD Board of Education or a Community College District or County Board of Education, or an employee of the LBUSD.
