



National Board Candidate Support Meetings 2018-2019

Any district teacher working on his/her National Board Certificate, regardless of being a district-sponsored candidate or not, can attend these voluntary support meetings.

LBUSD National Board Certified Teachers will be available to provide support for you as you go through the Candidacy phase. Support includes clarification of portfolio expectations/rubrics, reading and critiquing of portfolio entries, watching videos and providing feedback, technology, and answering any questions you might have.

Attendance of these meetings is not officially a part of the Pre-Candidate program (***and therefore will have no direct bearing on the Oversight Committee's decisions regarding acceptance into the Candidacy Program***).

There are four types of meetings you can attend and they are listed by upcoming dates.

Component 2, 3, and 4 Workshops:

A series of workshops designed to support NBCT Candidates through collaborative discussion of your lessons for differentiation (Component 2), lesson planning and analyzing (Component 3), and your work as a reflective practitioner (Component 4).

Each workshop will include the following information:

1. Component Deconstruction: What exactly do you need to do for this component? How do you provide evidence?
2. Know your Standards and Scoring: What do your Standards outline for this area? What is an accomplished teachers able to do/show in the situation? What areas does the rubric outline?
3. Map Out Your Game Plan: Use a Thinking Map to organize your plan.

*Note: The workshops do not cover specific content area, only a discussion on the management and mapping of the Component expectations.

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Component 1 Study Group:

A series of workshops designed to support NBCT Candidates through hands-on implementation of maps and flashcards for the three Content Knowledge timed assessments. Candidates will use visual mapping and specific strategy planning to focus on one of the questions.

Each workshop will include 30 minute sections:

1. Question Deconstruction – What exactly do you need to do for this question? How do you clearly answer the question? Take Away: flash cards
2. Know your Standards – Which standards are addressed in the question? What is an accomplished teacher able to do/show in the situation? Take Away: Flash Cards
3. Map Out Your Game Plan – Which thinking map could be used to organize your answer the question? What outline will you draft on your testing whiteboard during the test? Take Away: Page of skeleton/outline maps

*Notes:

- The workshops do not cover your specific content area, only the management and mapping of the Content Knowledge expectations. You will have study time to delve into the specifics of your content area.
- Bring your Content Area Standards and Assessment Instructions.
- You can attend both dates and plan/design/study for different questions during each session.
