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## Safety Procedures at Schools

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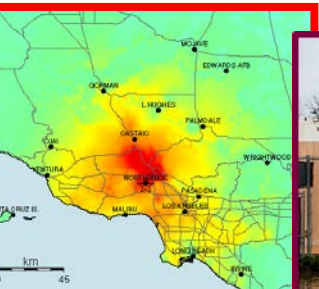
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The Safe School Plan supports our goal to provide a safe and positive learning environment and promote the educational success of all children.

# School Safety Plans

- LBUSD has adopted an emergency management system and response platform to guide schools with actions to respond to a school emergency and move students and staff to a safe location:
  - ◆ From natural disasters (earthquakes),
  - ◆ To forecasted events (severe weather),
  - ◆ To accidents (refineries),
  - ◆ And we plan for threats of school violence.



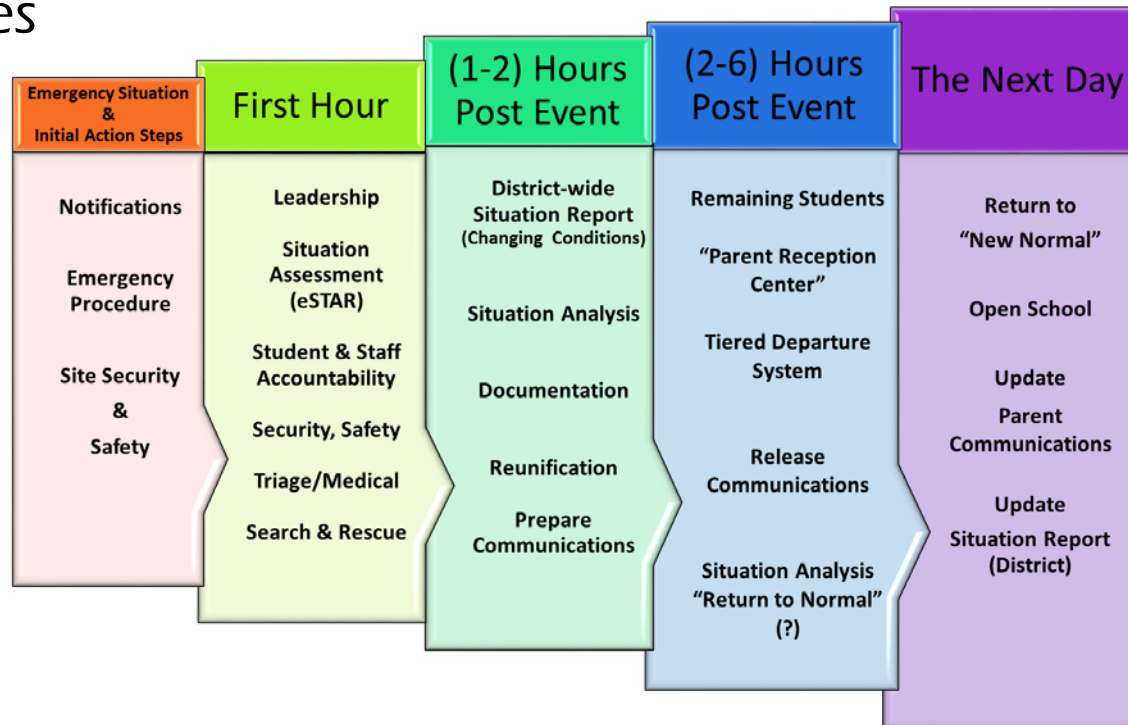
As a nation, we have seen an increase in threats and acts of violence.

At the first sign of a threat, the school will call 911 and activate a pre-recorded security alert to direct everyone to a safe location.

# School Safety Plans

- Schools update their safety plans each year
- Schools conduct emergency drills to practice emergency roles and responsibilities
- Personnel attend training and students participate in school exercises
