One evening in the fall designed for 12th grade students to help prepare them for scholarship, college, and work interviews and one evening in the spring to help lower grade students prepare for work and internship interviews that happen heading into the summer. Professional parents will interview each student and then provide them with feedback and coaching on an interview rubric. Teachers will be present in the interview rooms in order to provide certificated supervision for all of the interview groups.	Parent Involvement Other Student Outcomes
