Target Group: All groups, including sub-groups, of students and families that are identified through attendance data and other systems throughout the school.

Monitoring: Attendance data through Synergy as well as academic data will be used during each trimester to monitor growth towards established goals. Use of the SST system to initiate and monitor interventions and progress. Workshop meeting agendas, sign-in sheets and parent survey feedback will be used.
