Professional development will focus on core subject areas to support SBAC ELA and Math claims and implement Next Generation Science Standards. Teacher training in Computer Science Innovators and Makers, App Creators, Medical Detectives and Science of Technology will provide additional course offerings in the master schedule to support STEM focus.

Expected Outcome:

Departments will collaborate and implement common assessments and district assessments. Collaboration will help achieve school goal of 7% increase in both ELA and Math. Students will complete three years of PLTW, resulting in application to high school STEM related pathways and district specialized programs.
