Intervention Focus:

The foucus is to reduce the learning gap for students below proficiency as measured by SBAC, FRSA, Benchmark Assessments, Unit Assessments, and Math Facts. The following interventions will supplement core instruction to adress low proficienty rates, chronic absenteesim and attendance rates, suspension rates, student social and emotional well-being, self-efficacy and growth mindset, and to decrease the number of students who exhibit at-risk behaviors.

Expected Outcome:

We expect student acheivement to increase in all core subject areas as measured by district and state assessment data.

We expect student engagement to improve in the classroom through a focus on absenteesim, increased parent involvement, and enhanced teacher instruction. We expect school climate to improve through a focus on addressing at-risk behaviors, addressing/improvoing student social and emotional well-being, parent education and engagement, and implementation of a RTI plan for targeted students.
