WHY SHOULD STUDENTS/PARENTS CONSIDER DUAL ENROLLMENT?

- No enrollment costs while students are enrolled in high school.
- Earn college credits.
- Earn high school credit. For each 3 unit college course completed, high school students will earn 10 credits, if they submit their college transcript to their high school.
- Complete certificate and /or major requirements that will count towards a degree.
- Save time and money toward their degree.

Early College Pathways Partnership Program

Students participate in specially selected courses and student support services that are designed for college and career preparation.

BENEFITS OF ECPP PROGRAM

- Help in registering for classes within ECPP.
- Free textbooks when they participate in the ECPP Program. (lab fees may apply)
- Receive student support services such as mentoring and in class tutoring support.
- Student Support Team to assist students successfully enroll and complete the Long Beach City College courses.
- Complete certificate and /or major requirements that will count towards a degree in their chosen career pathway.
- Classes are offered during the Fall, Spring and Summer terms.

Who is Eligible?

- 11th and 12th graders are encouraged to participate.
- Students may start taking ECPP classes during the summer before their 11th grade year.
- All students that attend Long Beach Unified School District.

What if my child wants to take a different class?

- Students would be responsible for completing the registration process on their own.
- Students/parents will have to purchase the textbook.
- Additional lab fees may apply.

Process to Enroll

- Step 1: Visit LBCC Website
- Step 2: Create CCC Apply Account User Name and Password
- Step 3: Login and start LBCC Admissions Application
- Step 4: Complete and Submit LBCC Application

- Step 5: Complete the High School Dual Enrollment Form
- Step 6: Submit this form to careerpathways@lbcc.edu.
