

# CURRENTLY ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR Substitute Teachers



## Preschool and School Age Child Care Programs

Long Beach Unified School District is the third largest district in the State of California, serving a diverse student population. The Office of Child Development Centers serves over 2000 children and families in 25 centers.

### Qualifications

**Category I Teacher:** Applicant must have completed a minimum of 60 semester units of college-level work and hold or qualify for a valid California Child Development Teacher Permit.

Salary: \$15.52 an hour in a day-to-day assignment

\$18.63 an hour in a long-term assignment

**Category II Teacher:** Applicant must have completed a minimum of 28 semester units of college-level work (at least 16 semester units of general education and 12 ECE or child development units including the 3 core areas) and hold or qualify for a valid California Child Development Associate Teacher Permit.

Salary: \$13.52 an hour in a day-to-day assignment

This category is not eligible for a long-term substitute assignment.

### Work Hours

- Teachers may work up to 40 hours per week, Monday through Friday
- Centers are open from 6:30 am to 5:30 pm
- Hours are flexible and are based on the need of the program

### Job Description

- Supervises and instructs children in the Child Development Center under the direction of the Coordinating Teacher
- Maintains a responsive and safe environment
- Maintains a cooperative relationship with all staff members
- Supervises the proper use and care of all equipment and material in the center and on the playground
