Program Overview

The purpose of the Future Administrators Program is to recruit, train, support and retain high quality leaders, who will increase student achievement and close the achievement gap at our lowest-performing schools. Those selected for the Future Administrators Program attend a series of workshops that focus on the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare them for the assistant principalship at any level. In addition, selected program participants are mentored by assistant principals at school sites different than their own. Such participants may be eligible for available assistant principal openings or other leadership vacancies for up to three years upon successful completion of the program. The ideal candidate will have served in formal leadership roles such as Department Chair, Grade Level Leader, SBDM, Instructional Leadership Team, etc.

Eligibility Requirements:

- A minimum of three (3) years experience as a classroom teacher
- A valid California teaching credential and/or Services Credential
- A valid California administrative/supervisory credential (or qualify for a Certificate of Eligibility by May 2016)
- Demonstrated leadership experience as a teacher leader, counselor, facilitator, TOSA, program specialist or other comparable leadership position
- Recommendation and support of your current and/or previous supervisor to pursue the assistant principalship
- Willingness to work at the district's lowest achieving school sites
