NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPLY



The Long Beach Unified School District (LBUSD) is providing this notice of intent to apply for the After School Education and Safety grant. The applications are due on or before February 12th, 2016. This notice outlines LBUSD's plan for submitting these applications through the California Department of Education. This notice identifies LBUSD as the Local Education Agency responsible for submitting the applications for funding.

LBUSD operates an afterschool program known as Winners Reaching Amazing Potential (WRAP) at fifty-six school K-12 sites across the district. The program provides students with academic enrichment, homework help, physical activity and a nutritious snack at no cost to students or families.

The After School Education and Safety grant funding is currently used to fund the K-8 afterschool program sites across LBUSD. WRAP programs currently have a high demand to service more students. LBUSD intends to apply for funding for the 2016-2017 school year to continue to serve the maximum number of students possible in this free, daily afterschool program.
