Math Facts Conditions

Effective immediately, the conditions for administering and reporting math facts trimester scores in LROIX are as follows:

- Teachers will assess students on grade level math facts a minimum of once a month, per each operation, in all three trimesters.
- The highest **duplicated** math facts score, for each operation, during the trimester shall be recorded in LROIX.
****Example**** A fourth grade student gets a partial proficient (PP) score in September and in October a proficient (P) score on the multiplication math facts test. In November, the student scores an advanced proficient (AP) score on the multiplication test. The teacher will enter a proficient (P) score in LROIX. The proficient score was entered because there was not a duplication of the advanced proficient score.
- Research will use the math facts score that is reported in LROIX for the **third** trimester to determine whether or not a student is at risk of being retained.

These conditions were determined after discussions this year by Teachers' Council members. Teachers' Council representatives also shared information gathered through site discussions at each meeting. Representatives gave their final approval of these conditions on March 28, 2006.
