The Early Head Start (EHS) Teacher provides care and services to children ages six weeks to three years in an EHS center, home-based program option and to pregnant women in a home-based option. An Early Head Start substitute teacher is called on a day-to-day basis or may be assigned a long-term assignment at any of the 2 Early Head Start centers throughout the LBUSD boundaries.

Requirements:

- Associate of Arts Degree in Child Development/Early Childhood Education or related field, or
- Completed 60 units with 24 units ECD/CD including core courses plus 16 units in general education courses
- California Child Development Teacher Permit
- California Drivers License
- **Three units of infant/toddler coursework**
- **First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Certificate**
