- 1) Each League will send 2 representatives to the Playoffs.
- 2) The League Champion from each League will face the 2nd place team from the opposing League.

*It will be considered a tie if teams have equal # of losses (ie: 5-1 ties with 4-1).

If the tie involves teams that are guaranteed a Playoff position (top 2), the following tie breaker rules will apply:

- 3) If there is a 2-WAY tie, it will be determined by head to head competition. In the event the two teams did not face each other, a coin toss will determine the seeding.
- 4) IF THERE IS A 3-WAY TIE, it will be determined by total number of points allowed between the tied teams (least allowed), presuming all teams faced each other. In the event all teams did not face each other, it will be determined by COMPARITIVE W-L RECORDS VS. STANFORD (common opponent).
- 5) If a tie remains, it will be determined by total # of points allowed vs. Stanford. In the event Stanford is involved in the tie and all 3 teams did not face each other, the seeding will be determined by a coin flip.....unless the tie results in eliminating a team from making the Playoffs....in which case an abbreviated Playoff game/match between the tied teams will be arranged.
