While Fundraising with SMG

In an attempt to offset the cost of grade level field trips, as well as senior event costs, QUEST will be trying a new fundraiser this year. SMG is a company that organizes staffing for concession stands at public events, such as the Long Beach Grand Prix, Concerts, and other events. QUEST has learned that there is an opportunity to staff some of these events in return for a percentage of the proceeds. There is no cost to parents, just a commitment from students as well as PARENTS to staff these stands. In the venues where alcohol is served, students are not allowed to handle any transactions; we would therefore rely strictly on parents to handle all such transactions.

- The money earned would be used to offset the cost of:
 - ✧ 9th Grade Catalina Field Trip, May 16-18, Cost \$235.00.
 - ✧ 10th Grade San Diego College Tour Field Trip, March 6-8, Cost \$469.00.
 - ✧ 11th Grade Monterey History and Literature Tour Field Trip, Mar. 15-17, Cost \$379.00.
 - ✧ 12th Grade Events & Activities.
 - ✧ As well as contribute to the General Fund.

Currently, other Millikan Organizations, such as ROTC, and various sports teams, do their fundraising through SMG. For example, they staffed food booths at the Long Beach Grand Prix last year and depending on the group and the number of stands they staffed, made \$3,000 to \$6,000.

Obviously not all events are as large as the Long Beach Grand Prix. Profits for each venue will vary, depending on the size of event and the type of merchandise sold, however there is good earning potential with this fundraiser. The more events we do, the more funds we will have to **REDUCE** the cost of each QUEST student's field trip or 12th Grade activity expenses.
