USA FUNDS ACCESS TO EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Deadline: February 15th

Amount: \$1,500

- for seniors with annual family adjusted gross income of \$35,000 or less
- must be a U.S. citizen or eligible non citizens
- plan to enroll full-time in a degree-seeking program at a U.S.-accredited institution 2007-2008
- apply online at www.usafunds.org/scholarships

BEST BUY SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline: must apply online by February 15th

Amount: \$1,500 - \$10,000

- must demonstrate academic excellence (2.5+ G.P.A) & exemplary community service
- plan to enroll at a 2 or 4-year accredited college or university or trade school Fall 2008

Deadline: February 15th

Amount: \$2,000 - \$25,000

- must interview with scholarship committee if selected
