1. APPROVE NEW HIGH SCHOOL SCIENCE COURSE: FUNCTIONAL ACADEMICS: NGSS- COURSE 1

Approve the new special education course for high school, *Functional Academics: NGSS Course 1*. This course outline reflects the Linked Learning guiding principles and the LBUSD Strategic Plan's goals and objectives. This course is designed for students who receive Specialized Academic Instruction. The purpose of the course is to continue developing skills aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) while covering content that crosses the instructional domains of science (i.e., Life Science, Physical Science, Earth and Space Science, and Engineering, Technology, and Application of Science). The course is proposed for high school science credit.

2. APPROVE REVISED HIGH SCHOOL CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSE: BIOLOGY OF AQUACULTURE

Approve revised academic career concentrator course outline for Lakewood's Odyssey Pathway, entitled *Biology of Aquaculture*. This revised course outline reflects the Linked Learning guiding principles and the LBUSD Strategic Plan's goals and objectives. Students learn the principles of biology through the study of Aquaculture, the science of cultivating animals and plants in water. Students learn the biology, history, structure and function of aquatic animals and plants.

The following basic textbooks are recommended to support the implementation of this course:

Aquaculture Science, Parker, Rick, Delmar Cengage Learning, Third Edition 2012.

The Living Earth, Nowicki, Stephen, Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, 2020.

These textbooks meet the social compliance criteria for instructional materials established by the State of California. The course is proposed for high school graduation science credit and is a required course in a technical sequence.

3. APPROVE REVISED HIGH SCHOOL CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION: AUTOMOTIVE AND TRANSPORTATION TECHNOLOGY 1-2

Approve the revised regular status CTE concentration course for Poly's BEACH pathway, *Automotive and Transportation Technology 1-2*. The revised course outline reflects the Linked Learning guiding principles and the LBUSD Strategic Plan's goals and objectives. This course is designed to teach students about the operation and maintenance of modern automobiles.

The basic textbook recommended to support the implementation of this course is:

Modern Automotive Technology, James E. Duffy, Goodheart-Wilcox, Ninth Edition/2017.

This textbook meets the social compliance criteria for instructional materials established by the State of California. The course is proposed for high school graduation elective credit and is a required course in a technical sequence. In addition, this course will be resubmitted to UC for 'g' approval.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF EDUCATION

DECLARING SUPPORT FOR PROPOSITION 16**

WHEREAS, Native American, Latinx, Black, Asian, Pacific Islander and other people of color and women have historically faced racism and discrimination in the United States, including the denial of equal opportunity in employment and equal access to higher education; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. government in the late 1960s established affirmative action policies to address discrimination and bias toward racial minorities and women in hiring, government contracts, and access to higher education; and

WHEREAS, the passage of Proposition 209 in 1996 amended the California Constitution by prohibiting the consideration of race, sex and ethnicity in admission to public employment, higher education and public contracting; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 209 inhibited California state and local governments' ability to remedy the continuing effects of past discrimination through race-conscious programs, such as those designed to ensure access to higher education through the University of California, California State University and California Community Colleges; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 209 deterred the California Community Colleges, California State University and University of California from implementing race-conscious policies, services and interventions in programs that increase student achievement such as counseling, tutoring, outreach and financial aid; and

WHEREAS, the effect of Proposition 209 was to reduce the percentages of underrepresented students admitted to public institutions of higher education in California; and

WHEREAS, the repeal of Proposition 209 would additionally enable the California Community Colleges, California State University and University of California campuses to target enrollment and support efforts to address the higher education opportunity, transfer and completion gaps faced by Black and Latinx students; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 16 appears on the Nov. 3, 2020 General Election ballot, and if approved by the voters of California would repeal Proposition 209 and eliminate the state prohibition on the use of race, sex and other characteristics in considering admission to higher education, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified School District is unwavering in its support of programs, initiatives and policies designed to promote equity and inclusion.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified School District hereby endorses and expresses its support of Proposition 16, which will permit students, regardless of sex, race, ethnicity or national origin to access social and economic opportunities to achieve their highest potential
