**High School Summer School
General Information 2021**

ELIGIBILITY and SITES

High School summer school is open to any Long Beach Unified School District student who need to make up credit(s) required for graduation, fulfill A-G college entrance requirements, take a math preparation course or take an original credit course. Post eighth graders through post-twelfth graders should see their counselors regarding eligibility for specific core academic or district-funded courses. **Summer school enrollment is limited to those who attend a Long Beach Unified School District high school.** A minimum of 85% attendance is required for credit in non Apex courses. Students will not receive a passing grade if they are absent more than 10 hours (4 days) from a full session, non Apex course. All students must be enrolled for class credit.

Browning, Cabrillo, CAMS, Jordan, Lakewood, McBride, Millikan, Poly, Renaissance, Sato and Wilson High Schools will be open to students from post-eighth to post-twelfth grades. Current high school students should attend summer school at the site where they attend the regular school year. Students from Beach/Reid, should attend their neighborhood high school if the courses that they need are offered at that site. If a needed course is not available at your school, please contact your Counselor to discuss your options.

All courses will be held in person, on campus. We will have very limited course options and spaces for students who request an online summer program. These requests will reviewed on a case by case basis.

DRESS CODE REQUIREMENT: The LBUSD dress code is enforced during summer school.

Uniforms are required at Millikan and Wilson High Schools.

FREE LUNCHES: Lunches will be available to all students.

HOW TO ENROLL

1. Complete the online application through ParentVue, <https://parentlbsd.lbschools.net/enrollment>, between May 7th and May 28th.

2. Parents will receive an email at the address provided in the summer school application confirming that they have completed the application process for their student/s.
3. Students can select their classes for summer school by following these steps, [**Directions for Selecting Classes**](#) . Otherwise, your Counselor will select the courses that you need to meet graduation or “a-g” requirements. A student or parent can view the courses requests, once the Counselor enters them, in StudentVue or ParentVue. Please note that Counselors are working on many end of the year tasks and courses may not be entered until close to the end of the 2nd semester. Final course schedules will be available within ParentVue and StudentVue starting June 23rd.
4. **The deadline to submit the online summer school application is May 28th at midnight.**
