

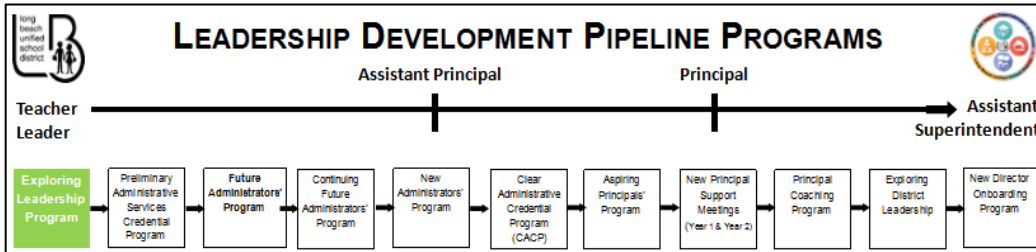

2019-2020 Professional Development Opportunity



Program Overview

The Exploring Leadership Program provides professional development to experienced teachers with strong instructional practice who are committed to educational change. Support includes professional development trainings, along with monthly site visits by Leadership Development staff. The goal of the program is to consistently develop a steady stream of teacher leaders who are current in district philosophy and practice. The ideal candidate serves in formal leadership roles (e.g., Department Chair, Grade Level Leader, Instructional Leadership Team, etc.), and is interested in developing leadership skills to support equity for all students, to create an inclusive school culture, and to close the achievement gap.

Eligibility Requirements

- A valid California Teaching Credential and/or Services Credential
- A minimum of three years of experience as a teacher, counselor, etc.
- Serving in formal leadership roles such as Department Chair, Grade Level Leader, Site Based Decision Making, Instructional Leadership Team, etc.
- Recommendation and support of your current and/or previous supervisor to pursue leadership opportunities.
- Commitment to the inclusion of all members of a diverse school community

To Apply

1. Complete the Google Form Application by 9/20/19, via the link on the Leadership Development web page (www.lbschools.net, click "L" on the A-Z directory, select Leadership Development, go to Exploring Leadership Program).
2. **Hand-deliver your resume and letter of intent** to the Leadership Development Office in the LBUSD Admin Building **between 9/3/19 and 9/20/19**. Resume and Letter of Intent information is available on the Leadership Development website.
3. Your principal/supervisor(s) will be contacted to complete a recommendation form. It is **highly recommended** that you contact your current and previous supervisor(s) to ask for their support.
