**Assistive Technology Specialist**

The AT (Assistive Technology) Specialist provides AT assessments and support to students who may need adaptations or equipment to access the curriculum or a Communication Device to participate fully in the classroom. The AT Specialist in this classification is responsible for assessing and determining eligibility for AT equipment/services; providing information for program development; participating as an active member of the Individualized Educational Program (IEP) team; monitoring student progress; providing training to IEP team members; maintaining inventory of equipment and warranties; maintaining case files and creating reports; performing a variety of instructional supports and services within a well-defined framework of policies, procedures and objectives; and doing other related work as required.
