



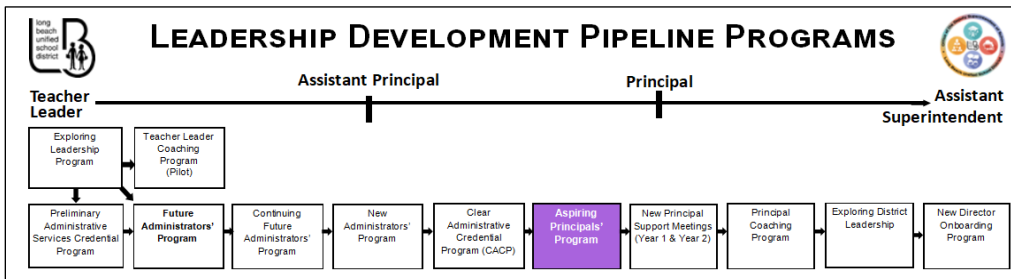

## Program Overview

The purpose of the Aspiring Principals' Program is to recruit, train, support, and retain high quality leaders who will increase student achievement and close the achievement gap. This program provides professional development, shadowing, and mentoring support to program participants. Workshops will focus on developing the qualities and skills of an effective principal, so that participants are prepared to successfully lead safe, inclusive, diverse campuses where all students thrive, socially, emotionally, and academically.

## Eligibility Requirements

- At least one complete year as an assistant/vice principal or other manager
- A valid California teaching credential and/or services credential
- A valid California Administrative/Supervisory Credential
- Demonstrated leadership in a management/supervisory position
- Support of your current and previous supervisor(s) to pursue the principalship
- Willingness to work at the district's lowest achieving school sites
- Commitment to the inclusion of all members of a diverse school community
