

Middle School Choice

Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer/Response
1. What if I don't have computer access or I don't know how to use ParentVue?	Contact your student's school site and ask for assistance.
2. Do I have to pick 3 other schools?	No. If you wish to attend your Middle School of Residence (MSOR), then select your MSOR only. Any other selections mean that you are willing to accept placement at those selections; please note that transportation is not provided and it is the parent's responsibility to get their child to school. Also keep in mind that you may be placed at your MSOR if there is no available space at your other school choices.
3. What if I change my mind and wish to go back to my home school?	Once you receive your assignment, we cannot guarantee placement BACK to the MSOR. Your space was granted to another student. Complete the appeal form for consideration in the online application.
4. What if I moved?	Address changes made by January 21st can be adjusted for a new MSOR. Address changes AFTER January 21st cannot be guaranteed. If you move after you receive your assignment, you can be placed on the overflow list and will have to wait and see the actual enrollment after the first day of school.
5. Why does my MSOR show "NORMS"?	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Address is outside LBUSD boundaries.2. Address is entered incorrectly.
6. Why do I get an ERROR page when I try to log on ParentVue?	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. ParentVue account has not been activated/registered.2. Parent does not have "Educational Rights." Check Parent profile.3. System is busy. Try again later.
7. What are the chances of getting one of my schools of choice?	Results vary annually and are dependent on the number of applicants per site (For example, 93% of last year's applicants received one of their 3 choices).
8. What if my child is GATE identified?	They are placed following the same placement protocol as all other students.
9. What if my child has RSP or Speech (DIS)?	Students are placed the same as all other students. All Middle and K-8 schools provide the same services.
10. What if my child is in a SDC program?	Students are placed by the Special Education Office following the same application protocol, based on available space and appropriate program. Transportation is not provided if you select another school.
