Prepayment Options for 2018/19

For parents who pay for breakfast and lunch:

Available for your convenience, we have an on-line payment system – mySchoolBucks at: <https://www.myschoolbucks.com>. The link to this on-line payment system is also available in ParentVUE. If you do not have an account and would like to set up an account, you will need to have your student’s nine-digit identification number (ID). Your student’s ID can be found in ParentVUE or on school documents such as a report card, registration paperwork, transcripts, ID card, etc. You may also send an email request for the student ID; simply follow the steps as you are creating an account for your student. You will have the ability to set up an e-mail notification for yourself when your student’s cafeteria account is low in funds. You do not need to make on-line deposits to be able to track your student’s account on-line. The on-line account is not available for students that attend California Academy of Math and Science (CAMS).

You still have the option to prepay for your student’s meals in the cafeteria. You may send cash or a check made out to the school cafeteria to be deposited in your student’s account (include student’s name in the memo section). As your student accesses his/her account, the dollar amount will be subtracted each time he/she purchases a meal. When the balance reaches \$5.00, your child will be reminded that the fund is getting low.

For 2018-19, the meal pricing for students who do not qualify for free or reduced-price meals are:

Meal Type	Grades Pre-Kindergarten to 5	Grades 6 to 12
Breakfast	\$2.00	\$2.25
Lunch	\$2.75	\$3.25

Here are examples of amount to deposit:

Meal Type	Grades Pre-Kindergarten to 5		Grades 6 to 12	
	One Week	Four Weeks	One Week	Four Weeks
Breakfast and Lunch	\$23.75	\$95	\$27.50	\$110
Lunch Only	\$13.75	\$55	\$16.25	\$65
