#### Breakfast and Lunch Meals Available to Children Ages 1-18

Long Beach Unified School District will provide meals to children during the Coronavirus (COVID-19) school closure period. Nutritious meals will be offered free at breakfast and lunch to children, ages one to 18 years old, at all Long Beach Unified School District school locations, (**except** for California Academy for Math and Science located at California State University, Dominguez Hills campus) for the first week of the closure. The District will evaluate its meal services offered based on individual site-based participation and revise as necessary the schedule and operating locations for all future weeks of the school closure period.

**Serving Dates: Monday to Friday, March 16<sup>th</sup> to March 20<sup>th</sup>**

**Breakfast Serving Times: 8 to 9 a.m.**

**Lunch Serving Times: 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.**
