

Screening Registration Process Cheat Sheet

In order for your child to participate in the COVID-19 screening at school, please use the link sent out via School Messenger. If you did not receive the notification please contact your school site.

While we think the registration form should be easy and take no longer than 5-8 minutes, there may be a few questions that seem confusing. This guide is designed to provide clarity and support for families as they complete the COVID-19 screening registration process.



If your student **HAS** been vaccinated against COVID-19, you do **NOT** need to complete this process

Register for a COVID-19 test.

Welcome! COVID-19 testing is one of the best ways to keep you, your family, and your coworkers safe. First, we will ask you to answer a few questions. We note where your answers are required due to state or federal requirements. Other questions are optional. Your answers to these questions will help inform contact tracing efforts.

Why is sharing health insurance information important?

This service is provided at no cost to you, whether you have insurance or not.

Color or California Department of Public Health and Perkin Elmer may attempt to bill your insurance to help cover the costs of testing. Nearly all health insurance companies cover the full cost of COVID-19 testing, as required by law.
