3 07/01/2019 The intervention teacher will improve student achievement by co-teaching and providing interventions for students BAC Math 08/30/2020 who are not reading at grade level expectations and have just passed the promotion criteria. The intervention Elementary Reading - Benchmarks teacher will pull out for small group instruction using CORE 5 interventions. Students served will increase their EL Reclassification reading benchmark by more than a year's. Those taking the SBAC will exceed the target grow th for ELA for their grade level. ELL students will improve their ELPAC levels by at least one level overall.
