Intervention Focus:

Students who are not meeting grade level expectations in reading, writing, math, attendance, and behavior need additional support. The support will be provided through small group instruction, social skills groups, and 1:1 mentoring. Increased parent contact will also support the students' progress in the identified areas.

Expected Outcome:

Increased student achievement in all areas as measured by SBAC, RAPID, End of Unit assessments for both ELA and Math, and attendance.
