2	08/28/2020 06/29/2021	As part of building a School Community program, parent classes and workshops will be offered at our Parent center. Several classes will be offered monthly. At least 1 Technology Class (2hrs per week) and 1 parenting class (2 hours per week) for a total of 4 hours per week. In addition we will also offer 1 ESL class (2hrs per week). Cost of implementation includes cost of chromebooks, technology equipment, reading and math materials and supplies/materials for adult classes. It also includes cost of teacher or special speaker or instructor to lead workshop sessions and/or any day care that is needed for parents. As an intervention, parents will work with their child after-school in literacy classes (10 week sessions 2 times a year) where they will use chromebooks to access reading programs, complete family research projects and powerpoint presentations.
