Long Beach Unified School District is the third largest district in the State of California, serving a diverse student population. The Head Start program is funded to serve 332 infants/toddlers and 1,008 children, as well as their families, in 24 centers throughout the Long Beach Unified School District boundaries.

LBUSD Head Start program is accepting applications for the position of Head Start Teacher and Early Head Start Teacher in the Head Start Preschool program.

## Requirements:

- Hold an AA Degree or higher (BA/BS or MA/MS) in Child Development/Early Childhood Education or related field, inclusive of 24 ECE units
- Hold and maintain a valid California Child Development Teacher Permit
- Hold and maintain 16 hours certification including 8 hours of Pediatric First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), as well as an 8-hour Preventative Health & Safety Course (that includes the new mandated nutrition component) upon hire or within 30 days of employment
- Have 2 years of experience working with children ages 0-5 years old
- Required vaccination for Pertussis and Measles prior to hire, influenza vaccine is required annually during the flu season
- Once employed, onboarding process includes a 4-point criminal background check including: Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Department of Justice (DOJ), California Department of Justice Child Abuse Central Index (CACI), and Megan's Law Database
- Early Head Start ONLY: Have 3 units of infant/toddler coursework
